ATPL INTEGRATED

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 17 years of age
- Sufficient knowledge of English language
- Hold EASA Medical Certificate Class 1
- Successful completion of Pre-Entry Assessment Test

COURSE DURATION

The average time required to complete ATPL course is 14-18 months, including Training and Exams.

THEORETICAL TRAINING

ATPL Theory consists of 13 subjects and includes 750 hrs of classroom training, interactive video training, homework assignments, sample Exams, Pre-Assessment Tests and Progress Tests.

FLIGHT TRAINING

Total of 208 hrs, 134 hrs of them are conducted on Single Engine Piston aircraft (SEP/IR), 13 hrs on Multi Engine Piston aircraft (ME/IR), 41 hrs on FNPT II (F/S), 20 hrs MCC F/S for Multi Crew Cooperation Course or 40hrs on A320 APS/MCC/JOC.

COURSE COST

Tuition fees Course cost is paid with installments predefined timeline.

Alexandroupolis airport allows students to fly solo, as there are several training areas around the airport within the TMA (Terminal Monitoring Area) or close to it and many appropriate licensed airfields.

SAFETY

The excellent weather conditions in Alexandroupolis facilitate uninterrupted training all year round, without wasting precious time and money.

In summer, high temperatures are usually between 27 and 33 degrees Celsius, although sometimes climb higher. In the fall and winter months, nights are significantly cooler, and normal daytime high temperatures are between 21 and 25 degrees Celsius.
